The Event – Yogis Unite for George

In preparation to go to Bikram yoga teacher training in August 2007, George was found to have irreversible renal failure. His kidneys were functioning at only 7%. The doctors immediately admitted him to the hospital. It seemed apparent this had been going on for some time, yet George was practicing Bikram yoga five times a week, training karate, working full time as an iron-worker, and taking care of his family. Although there are no specific medical tests to ultimately prove what kept and keeps George 'healthy' during this

crisis, his doctors, his family, his friends, and George himself believes it was his Bikram yoga practice. George began dialysis and began the search for a donor. George's sister, Val, is a perfect match. They are scheduled for surgery in Las Vegas on July 1, 2008. This fundraising event will assist the McLaurin family with their massive medical expenses and lengthy recoveries.
